2018 Pinot Noir Rosé Coelho Estates

Tasting Notes

Rose pink in the glass, this crisp rosé offers a yeasty nose going cantaloupe and light peach followed by strawberries in cream. The palate leads with crisp acid supporting peach, strawberry, and dried mango fruit finishing with tart red fruit.

Winemaking Notes

This direct press rosé is nearly entirely the aromatic Dijon 777 clone of Pinot Noir, 60% from Coelho Vineyard and the balance from Delfina Vineyard. After a 5-hour maceration in the press, the berries were pressed and the juice settled in tank before being racked to 500-liter puncheons. Fermented 50% in a oncefilled acacia puncheon and 50% in a once-filled French oak puncheon.

Vineyard Notes

This wine is blended from our three vineyards: Coelho Vineyard in the Van Duzer Corridor AVA with Missoula Flood sedimentary soil, Delfina Vineyard in the McMinnville AVA with volcanic soil, and Zeitoun Vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA with a mix of eroded volcanic rock over marine sedimentary soil.
